- 1. Rules: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 2. Eligibility and Entry: The regatta is open to all sailboats owned by members of FHYC which have a FHYC or NC PHRF rating. Boats that are not rated shall apply for a FHYC rating no later then April 6th. Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it together with the required fee to Georgie Jackson, 1210 Pelican Dr, no later than April 13th.
- **3. Fee:** The entry fee shall be \$25.
- **4. Classes:** The fleet may be separated into two or more classes if there are at least two boats in each class. Anticipated classes are Ensign, cruising and non-spinnaker. The use of spinnakers will not be allowed. The class assignments will be determined by the PRO and dependent on the entries received. Multi-hulls are welcome.

- **6. Sailing Instructions:** Sailing Instructions will be emailed to skippers on or before April 15th and will be available at the skippers' meeting.
- **7. Venue:** The race will be held on the Neuse River in an area approximately bounded by Broad Creek # 2, NR 13, NR 17, NR 19 and Northwest Creek #1.
- **8.** Course: The starting and finishing lines will be between an orange flag on the Signal Boat and the nearby Northwest Creek marker 1N. Course to be sailed will be announced at the skippers' meeting. The first boat to start will have a start in accordance with rule 26. Other boats will start at a delayed time from the first start. Those time delays will be given to each skipper at the skippers' meeting. Boats will be reminded, by channel 67, of their delayed start time. In the event that a boat is on the course side at her start time, she shall return completely to the prestart side of the line before starting.
- **9. Scoring:** The order of finish will be the order of placement. This will be a pursuit start race. Handicaps will be calculated based on the length of course selected and will be taken at the start.
- **10. Awards:** One award will be given for each three boats in a class. The overall winner will be the first boat to finish and will have its name placed on the Wilkerson perpetual trophy in the Community Center. There is also a "hold for year" trophy for the overall winner. One completed race shall constitute the regatta.
