Sailing Instructions

1 Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*

2 Entries

Competitors may enter by delivering a completed entry form and paying the entry fee to 1210 Pelican Dr.

3 Notices to Competitors

Notices to competitors will be posted during skippers' meeting at Red Sail Park

4 Signals made ashore

Signals will not be displayed ashore. If there is a postponement the PRO will announce it over VHF channel 67 at 1230 and again at 1245. The first class warning flag will not be displayed until one hour after the postponement has been ended by notification over VHF channel 67.

5 Schedule and class flag

A skippers' meeting will be held at Red Sail Park at 1000 on April 15th. The warning signal for the first start will be at 1325. The class flag is red.

6 Racing area

The racing area will be on the Neuse River in the vicinity of Fairfield Harbour

7 Course and Marks

The course for the day will be presented to competitors at Red Sail Park during the skippers' meeting.

8 Starting and finishing lines, starting system

The starting and finishing line will be between an orange flag on the Signal boat and Northwest Creek mark 1N. The start will be a pursuit start. Each boat will be given its delay from the first start at the skipper' meeting. There will be a regular rule 26 sequence for the first boat to start. Other boats will be reminded of their time by VHF67.

9 Time limit

There will be no time limit for the first boat to finish. All other boats shall finish within 30 min. of the first boat or be scored DNF

10 Protest

Protest shall be delivered to PRO within 1 hour after the Signal boat docks. PRO can be contacted at 610-653-8478

11 Scoring

The order of finish shall be the order of placement.
