# FAIRFIELD HARBOUR YACHT CLUB Sunfish & Dinghy Series 2024

# **Notice of Race**

The Fairfield Harbour Yacht Club, Ltd. (FHYC) is the Organizing Authority for the series.

#### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by rules as defined in the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing including the prescriptions of US Sailing, except as changed by this NoR or by the sailing instructions.
- 1.2 Specific attention is directed to RRS Fundamental Rules 1.1 and 3, which state:
  - 1.1 A boat or competitor shall give all possible help to any person or vessel in danger.
  - 3. The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone.
- 1.3 The first sentence of rule 44.1 is changed to: "A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 in an incident while racing."

# 2. ELIGIBILTY

- 2.1 This event is open to Sunfish and other small one-design sailing dinghies.
- 2.2 Competitors are not required to be a member of FHYC or US Sailing to participate.
- 2.3 There may also be an open class for small boats which do not constitute a one-design providing there are a minimum of 3 entries.

#### 3. ENTRY AND FEE

- 3.1 Entry is made by completing the Entry Form in Attachment 1.
- 3.2 The entry fee for the full series is \$10.00.

# 4 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 4.1 A total of 54 races are scheduled.
- 4.2 Three races are scheduled each day: Apr 7, 14, 21 & 28; May 5, & 19; Jun 2, 9, 23 & 30; Sep 8, 15, 22 & 29; Oct 6, 13, 20 & 27.
- 4.3 Additional races may be held each race day at the discretion of the RO and verbally confirmed by each competitor.
- 4.4 The first signal for the first race each day is 1400 (2:00pm).
- 4.5 On the last scheduled day Oct. 27<sup>th</sup> of racing, no warning signal will be made after *1530* (3:30pm). Awards party will be held Oct 27 shortly after the last race of the day.

# 5. RACING AREA

Races will be held at Fairfield Harbour in the Inner Harbour in the vicinity of the boat launch ramp.

## 6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available to each competitor prior to the start of the series. They may be provided by email.

#### 7 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors prior to 1100 race each day will be provided via email or telephone.

# 9 <u>COURSES</u>

The course for each race is intended to be generally windward/leeward.

#### 10 SCORING

- 10.1 The series will be scored using a high point scoring system with place scores to be accumulated as follows: First = Number of competitors (N), Second N-1, Third N-2, Fourth N-3, and so on. This changes RRS Appendix A.
- 10.2 12 races are required to be participated to constitute a series.
- 10.3 A boat's series score is the total of her race scores with no exclusions.
- 10.4 When fewer than 12 races have been participated, a boat's series score is the total of her race scores.

#### 11 PRIZES

- 11.1 Prizes will be awarded for first, second and third places in the series.
- 11.2 Additional prizes will be given to each boat that participated in a minimum of 12 races.

#### 12 SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 12.1 RRS 40.1 shall apply: Each competitor shall wear a personal flotation device (PFD) while sailing. Wet suits and dry suits are not adequate personal buoyancy.
- 12.2 A boat which retires from the race shall notify the Race Committee before leaving the race course area or, if that is not possible, immediately upon arriving ashore.

#### 13 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be either self-insured or carry adequate, valid third-party liability insurance.

# 14 RISK ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**
